



Facility Clinical Education Co-ordinator (FacCEC)

Steps for use of the APPLinkup training site

Step 1: Notify the university you are going to do some training. This will ensure that the university has enrolled students and allocated them to a facility for you to practise allocation. Each university has been provided with unique user names and passwords and simulated student data for use in training

Step 2: Go to the APPLinkup training site and select the Resources tab:

Step 3: Open up the APPLinkup Training Resources page

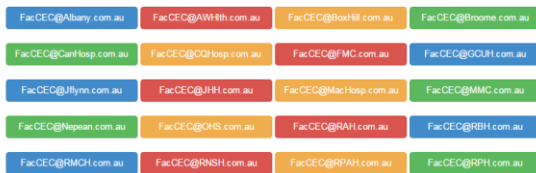

Step 4: Open the FacCEC user level section. Select one of the FacCEC user accounts and password (apple1) provided and log into the training system

Step 5: Use the APPLinkup user manual and work through allocating students to clinical educators

Step 6: To be able to practise completing and viewing an APP form you will need to log in as a clinical educator. Use the CE account and password (apple1) with the same account name provided in the Resource tab. Eg., If you used FacCEC@Albany.com.au then use CE@Albany.com.au

Step 7: Complete and submit a mid and end of unit APP form following instructions in the manual.

Step 8: Once you have submitted these forms as the CE you can log out

Step 9: As the Facility CE Co-ordinator you may need to be able to provide guidance and training to your Clinical Educators (CE) on how to use the system.

To maximise the effectiveness of training it is best to practise these steps alongside your clinical educators.

Assessment of Physiotherapy Practice (APP) Mid Unit

0 = Infrequently / rarely demonstrates performance indicators
1 = Demonstrates few performance indicators to an adequate / pass standard
2 = Demonstrates most performance indicators to an adequate / pass standard
3 = Demonstrates most performance indicators to a good / above pass standard
4 = Demonstrates most performance indicators to an excellent standard
Not Assessed (n/a) = item was not assessed
Note: a rating of 0 or 1 indicates that minimum acceptable competency has not been achieved
