Steps for use of the APPLinkup training site

Step 1: Go to the APPLinkup training site and click on the Resources tab:

Step 2: Open up the APPLinkup Training Resources page

Step 3: Open the UniCEM user level section. Select the UniCEM user account for your university (password: apple1) and log into the training system. Download the simulated student list provided for your university on this page.

Step 4: Use the APPLinkup user manual and work through setting up your university program; registering and allocating students (use the simulated student list provided for your university). Allocate students to the facility provided.

Step 5: To be able to practise completing and viewing an APP form you will need to log in as a clinical educator. Use the CE user name and password (apple1) provided and complete and submit a mid and end of unit APP form following instructions in the manual.

Step 6: If you wish to also view the system as your students would, log in as the student whose APP form the CE has just submitted. The student's user name will be their email address and password is apple1.

Step 7: Once you have submitted these forms you can now log out as the CE or student and log back in as the UniCEM and view and ratify the completed form.

Step 8: As UniCEM you will need to be able to provide guidance and training to your Facility Clinical Education Co-ordinators (FacCEC), Clinical Educators (CE) and Students (S) on how to use the system. Use the simulated student list, user names and passwords provided to work through each of these additional user levels
